Thank you for your interest in NSBA's 2025 Small Business Taxation Survey.

Among some of the key findings of the survey:

- The majority of small-business owners spend more than 20 hours per year dealing with federal taxes, even though the vast majority (71 percent) pay an external tax practitioner to handle their taxes.
- Ninety percent of small-business owners say federal taxes impact the day-to-day operations of their business, one-in-three cite a significant impact.
- Among the small-business respondents who said they directly outsource goods from outside the U.S., the vast majority identified China as a country they purchase from.
- More than half of small-business owners say that finding information directly from the IRS is difficult.
- By far, administration and complexity is the largest burden facing small businesses when it comes to federal taxes, NOT the financial cost.

For years, NSBA has been warning policymakers about the challenges posed by various sunsetting laws and how those create additional hardships that fall squarely on the shoulders of small businesses. Today, that fear is front-and-center as Congress must address the expiration of various small-business tax cuts including the 199A Qualified Business Income Deduction—top priorities as voted on at NSBA's recent Small Business Congress.

As Congress embarks on this tax extender discussion, it is imperative that small businesses are afforded tax stability, predictability, and permanency, not to mention parity with larger businesses.





The vast majority of small-business owners say federal taxes have some impact on the **day-to-day operations** of their businesses.



The vast majority of small-business owners spend more than \$100 per month on payroll services.


1-in-5 small firms spend more than \$1,000 per month.






APPROXIMATELY HOW MUCH TIME DOES YOUR COMPANY SPEND DEALING WITH SALES TAXES?


DO YOU COLLECT SALES TAX ON TRANSACTIONS CONDUCTED ONLINE?




- 1. Exemption for small firms under a certain gross receipts threshold

- 6. One national collection office which remits taxes to states on behalf of the business



HAS YOUR BUSINESS BEEN ADVERSELY IMPACTED BY ANY TARIFF HIKES ON CHINESE GOODS?




For those that indicated they directly outsource goods from outside the U.S., the **vast majority identified China** as a country they purchase from.





More than half of respondents said they were concerned about increased tariffs under the Trump administration.


More than half of small-business owners say that finding needed information and/or answers directly from the IRS is difficult.


1-in-3 say it is very difficult to impossible.


HOW DID YOU REACH OUT TO THE IRS FOR HELP?






WHAT WAS THE OUTCOME OF THAT OUTREACH?

WAS YOUR ISSUE RESOLVED IN A WAY THAT WAS USEFUL?







For those who have reached out to the IRS for assistance or clarification, more than half experienced a significant delay or never received a response.




Almost half of small businesses reported that the IRS assistance they received was not useful.






WHICH OF THE FOLLOWING TAX INCENTIVES HAVE YOU TAKEN ADVANTAGE OF?










For the overwhelming majority of small businesses, expiration of the TCJA tax cuts will be a significant issue.












WHICH OF THE FOLLOWING BEST DESCRIBES THE STRUCTURE OF YOUR BUSINESS?

HOW MANY TOTAL FULL-TIME PERSONNEL ARE CURRENTLY EMPLOYED BY YOUR BUSINESS?






WHAT WERE YOUR GROSS SALES OR REVENUES FOR YOUR MOST RECENT FISCAL YEAR?

WHAT WAS YOUR TAXABLE INCOME FOR 2022?


